## Students Award University More Top Marks

For the third year in a row, TWU students have given their university an A+ in Quality of Education. The Globe and Mail's annual *Canadian University Report* was released on October 23, awarding the university top marks in such categories as class size, quality of teaching and a sense of security on campus.

TWU ranked exceptionally high in most education polls, scoring A+'s in nearly every teaching category. TWU also scored the second highest mark among all Canadian universities for Course Availability and Variety, earning a B+.

The ratings are the result of extensive research by The Globe and Mail. The newspaper surveyed more than 43,400 students at 55 of Canada's universities on topics ranging from student's overall satisfaction to residence services.

Dr. Jonathan Raymond, TWU President, believes the small yet rigorous atmosphere at TWU contributes to the school's success. "Our small class sizes and opportunities for students to connect and engage directly with our faculty and staff are key to the satisfaction our students experience," he noted.
